



EQUIPMENT: Scoring Sheet

Pathfinders meet with their counselors and he gives them a song title they are to hum. Pick out several Christmas Carols and give the same Carol to three or four Pathfinders. (Same Carol to different Pathfinders in different units). At the sound of the bells they may begin. The group that gets together first is the winner. Be sure to remember what song was given to what Pathfinder so you can tell if they are in the right group.

The second time a counselor may join the group. The purpose of this game is to not only entertain them but also divide them into groups for the next game. At the conclusion of the game ask them to remain in the same group for the next game.

Paper
Felt Pens

Have a staff member ready to pass out pencils and paper to each group immediately following the Humming Game. This will prevent loss of attention and restlessness. Representatives of each group come to you for the song title. (You will find it best to have them written boldly with felt marker on a 8½ x 11 sheet of paper. In this way you will prevent being overheard). Reveal song title to Pathfinder and he is to go back to group and draw a picture representing the title. The group is to guess until right guess is made. The Pathfinder making the drawing is never allowed to talk. This may be played any number of times.

The grand winner may be first in line for refreshments. During refreshments a short movie may be shown. Free movies on winter sports may be obtained through your public library. Or the young people can begin preparation to decorate the Christmas tree.

Work with your Dorcas Society in selecting a worthy family. If at all possible the family should have Pathfinder-age young people. Have Pathfinders bring little gifts for boys or girls (whatever the case may be in that family) or have a good basket prepared for the family. After decoration of tree (strings of popcorn and candy canes may be used in decoration) and end of party, have Pathfinders and counselors go over to family and deliver the Christmas tree and baskets. Pathfinders may sing Christmas Carols with family before leaving.

Transportation for both Pathfinders and Christmas tree should be made far in advance and checked thoroughly to assure that there will be no complications.
