

# FRISBEE THROW

**CONTESTANTS:** 4 Pathfinders per club

**EQUIPMENT:** One or more frisbees

**PROCEDURE:** Each team member gets 2 throws.  
Points of entry team are totaled  
Emphasis is on accuracy  
If frisbee lands on line - the points are determined by which area the majority of frisbee is on.

# FRISBEE GOLF

**PARTICIPANTS:** 4 Pathfinders from each club

**EQUIPMENT:** 4 frisbees  
9 "holes" (may be containers or other objects)  
1 score sheet & pencil

**PROCEDURE:** A course will be laid out with 9 "holes". The object is to throw the frisbee and get it to the "hole" with the least amount of throws. The score keeper will keep score for each of the four Pathfinders.

Pathfinder number 1 will throw the frisbee toward the "hole". Pathfinder number 2 will continue, then Pathfinder number 3 and Pathfinder number 4. After each has had the throw, the next Pathfinder throws until all have arrived at the "hole". The Pathfinders must either hit the "hole" if an object, or throw it into a container.

**SCORE:** The team score is added together, counted and scored as follows:

1st place	108 or less throws	10 points
2nd place	109 - 125 throws	7 points
3rd place	126 - 144 throws	5 points
Entry	over 144 throws	3 points

# GLIDER THROW

**PARTICIPANTS:** One Pathfinder from each club

**EQUIPMENT:** Glider furnished by each club. For consistency in work and performance the clubs should use gliders in, or similar to, the **JETCO** series. All gliders will be built by members of the club and will not be purchased pre-assembled. All gliders will have a wingspan no shorter than 30" tip to tip, no longer than 36" tip to tip. \* \*

**PROCEDURE:** Each club will enter one Pathfinder who will line up on a starting line with others entering the event. The glider will be thrown. Standards will be set for distance to determine the points allowed. All gliders will be thrown at the same time in this event. Each club will make several gliders and then choose the best one. The club may also choose the one to throw the glider. Only one throw will be allowed. Each glider must be clearly marked with the name of the club entering it. Performance will be measured by the total "straight line distance" covered by each glider in flight measured from a pre-determined starting point.

\* \* Gliders of the **JETCO SERIES** can be purchased at any good hobby shop for a reasonable price.
