

# SEWING BUTTONS RELAY

**PARTICIPANTS:** 6 Pathfinders from each club

**EQUIPMENT  
NEEDED:**

Conference will provide:  
Buttons (six ½" 4-hole  
buttons) thread, needle and  
cloth.

**PROCEDURE:**

Mark off a starting line and an activity line 25' apart. A team of 6 Pathfinders will stand in relay fashion (one behind the other) at the starting line. At the starting signal, sound of the starting gun, Pathfinder number 1 will run from the starting line to the activity line. At that point the Pathfinder will pick up the needle and thread it -(without a needle threader!) Pathfinder number 1 will then pick up a button and sew it onto the cloth. The needle must pass through the cloth six (6) times - or three revolutions through each side in a consistent pattern. Pathfinder number 1 will then finish sewing the button by knotting the end of the thread on the reverse side of the cloth and cutting off the remaining thread. Pathfinder number 1 will then run back and tag Pathfinder number 2 who will follow the same procedure. Pathfinder number 2 will run and tag Pathfinder number 3 and so on until all six buttons have been sewed on the piece of cloth.
