

JUDGING HEIGHT

PARTICIPANTS: All Pathfinders may participate in this event.

PROCEDURE: How high is it? Any number of Pathfinders may work together to ascertain the height of the object chosen. Consult the Pathfinder Field Guide for a way to calculate height. Any object will be erected or designated such as a flag pole, building, or tree. The Pathfinders are to determine its height. Only one answer for each club will be accepted.

SCORING:

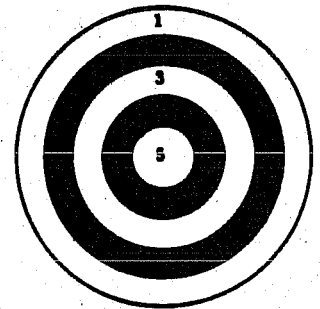
- 20 points for coming within 12 inches of exact height
- 15 points for coming within 24 inches of exact height
- 10 points for coming within 36 inches of exact height
- 5 points for entering
- 20 points maximum possible for this event.

ARCHERY

PARTICIPANTS: 2 Pathfinders (1 boy and 1 girl) from each club

EQUIPMENT: Conference/mission will provide the following:

- Targets
- Arrows (bring own if you prefer)
- Bows (5 feet -- 25 and 40 pounds)



PROCEDURE:

1. Three shots are allowed for each individual entering the event. Each arrow will be counted depending upon where it hits the target, with the center bulls eye counting 10 points and each ring going out will be 9,8,7 . . . 3,2,1 points.

2. The targets will be placed 60 feet from the shooting point.

3. A Pathfinder will be allowed 2 free shots prior to his three regular shots for the event. Neither of the 2 free shots will count toward the score regardless of the outcome of the last three.

SCORING:

First place	20 points
Second place	15 points
Third place	10 points
Entry	5 points
